Clivus Multrum is the world's first and foremost waterless composting toilet. The first model was released in 1964 in Sweden and its use soon spread to other parts of Europe and the US.



While touring the US in 1980 with permaculture co-originator Bill Mollison I first encountered the Clivus Multrum (aka "Clivus") at the eco-futuristic Integral Urban House in Berkeley, California. Months later I saw a Clivus in the Grand Canyon National Park and two years later at the Centre for Appropriate Technology in Wales. Returning to Australia I became the W.A. distributor and

enjoyed that role for several years during the 1980s. Almost 30 years later I decided to reconnect with the company and continue to promote the much loved Clivus, not only in WA but throughout Australia and Asia.

Clivus Multrum is suited to a wide range of climates and circumstances from Tiny Homes through to large public installations (CM20, CM40) in private (eg Caravan Parks) and public parks (State and National Parks). In between are suburban homes, mining sites, clubhouses, rest rooms & rest stops (CM10, CM14). We're experts in remote, waterless, public toilet solutions. We provide the simplest and most reliable, waterless toilet systems.

We're continually improving our designs to suit Australian conditions and needs. For example, we recently released the CM2, which is a great 2 person full time or 4 person part time composting toilet that is easy to install yourself and just as easy to use. At only AU\$900.00 this model proves popular for weekenders and as an economical and pleasant alternative to a drop toilet. It's perfect for Tiny Homes. It can also be used as a temporary toilet solution whilst building a house.

However, there are situations that require a different design solution and we cater for these with other brands including Ecolet, Kazooba, Nature-Loo and Sun Mar. For example, for a Tiny Home the Sun-Mar GTG Toilet is an alternative to the CM2 in situations where an approved system is needed. The newer CM2 is still undergoing the approval process and so is best where an unapproved system is acceptable. Competitively priced at AU \$1,400, the GTG is perfect for boats, Tiny Homes, cottages and cabins, motorhomes, RVs, farms, basements, warehouses, greenhouses, garages, barns, stables, trailers, mines, aircraft hangars, yurts, pools, sheds and more. 

The CM2 uses the process of organic decomposition to break down waste into safe compost. Removal of the compost chambers is as easy as opening the toilet lid, removing the compost chamber and replacing it with an empty one.

A 12volt 5watt fan aids the composting process and removes any odours.

Once installed there is no need to disconnect anything because, unlike other low-cost waterless composting toilets, the CM2 pedestal remains in place with only the internal compost chamber changing. The CM2's capacity can be increased by introducing additional composting chambers.

Free Compost

The CM2 is a great 2 person full time composting toilet that is easy to install yourself and just as easy to use. This model proves popular as a temporary toilet solution whilst building a house, for weekenders and as an economical and pleasant alternative to a drop toilet.

With a simple design, this waterless toilet system is great for the environment and has been installed in a variety of homes and settings from forest homes, suburban homes, properties (cattle, sheep, etc) and everything else in between. This system is also a great lesson for children about the impact of humans on the environment (girls and boys and young children quickly get over their 'Poophobia' to learn about the benefits) and will teach them to care for their surroundings for years to come. (That's a world we certainly want to live in!)



How does this 2 person waterless toilet system work?

Using the process of simple organic decomposition to break down waste into safe compost, the CM2 produces odourless compost (it will smell like rich, dark, moist and healthy garden soil).

How long does it take to fill up a container?

The CM2 comes with 2 x 32 litre containers (with a 25 litre capacity) that on average will collect about 2-4 weeks worth of material (depending on use). If you have more than 2 people using the system full time, these times may vary. After a few weeks of using the CM2 system you will have a good idea of how often the container needs to be emptied.

Where can I empty the waste?

This is a personal choice but ultimately all waste from the CM2 waterless composting toilet systems should be added to some form of composting bin, heap or container. This will eventually turn into usable compost that is great for your garden. Another option many customers take is to put the lid on the container and let the waste compost within the container itself. This usually takes around 60 days and then you are able to reuse the container.

Installation information

Once installed there is no need to disconnect anything because, unlike other low-cost waterless composting toilets, the CM2 pedestal remains in place with only the internal compost chamber changing. 


